Where to Park: The San Jacinto Garage.
(See SJG on the map above.)

This parking garage is located between the streets of San Jacinto and Trinity. **It is a pay-as-you-exit facility.** SJG has **no cashiers at the exits.** After you park, be sure to **take your garage entry ticket with you.** After your visit, you pay on level 3 at the self-service pay station. Only cash and credit cards are accepted.

On-Street Meter Parking

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

1. **Don't forget your music books! One original of the music must be provided for the judge.**
2. When you arrive at the building, there will be signs on or near the entrance doors. These signs will give you the room numbers of the judges. (If the room number is 4.123, the room is on the 4th floor; if the room number is 5.123, the room is on the 5th floor.) The temporary office for our events is usually in room M 3.110 or ask one of our ADMTA volunteers with a badge for help.
3. **NEW POLICY: ADMTA students are not allowed to use the practice rooms for our events.**
4. Arrive **15 minutes** early at your assigned room. A monitor will be standing outside the door. Check in with the monitor who will let you know if things are running on time, where to stand in line, etc. Important: Please be quiet in the halls.
5. When it is time for you to perform for the judge, open your music books to the correct pages and give them to the monitor.
6. The monitor will assist you as you enter the room when you will take instructions from the judge.
7. When you are finished performing, you are free to leave unless you have been instructed otherwise by your teacher for the event.
