Where to Park: The San Jacinto Garage.

(See SJG on the map above.)

This parking garage is located between the streets of San Jacinto and Trinity. **It is a pay-as-you-exit facility.** SJG has **no cashiers at the exits.** After you park, be sure to **take your garage entry ticket with you.** After your visit, you pay on level 3 at the self-service pay station. Only cash and credit cards are accepted.

Parking Rates range from \$3 to \$18.

On-Street Meter Parking

There is limited parking on 26th Street (E. Dean Keeton). You will have to feed the meters every hour or so.

Another Garage Option: The Manor Garage (MAG) is located at 2017 Robert Dedman Dr., Austin 78712

It is across from the football stadium. Take the level 4 entrance (off of a short street called Clyde Littlefield Dr.)

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

1. **Don't forget your music books!** One original of the music should be given to the judge.
2. When you arrive at the building, there will be signs on the entrance doors and along the walls of the ground floor. These signs will give you the room numbers of the judges. (If the room number is 4.123, the room is on the 4th floor; if the room number is 5.123, the room is on the 5th floor.)
3. Arrive a little early at your assigned room. A monitor will be standing outside the door. Check in with her and she will let you know if things are running on time, where to stand in line, etc.
4. When it is time for you to perform for the judge, open your music books to the correct pages and give them to the monitor.
5. The monitor will assist you as you enter the room when you will take instructions from the judge.
6. When you are finished performing, you are free to leave unless you have been instructed otherwise by your teacher for the event.
